

VILLAGE OF PUGWASH

ELECTORS MEETINGS

BY – LAW NO. 3

Notice:

3.01 The Clerk/Treasurer shall give notice of the time, date, and place of the electors meeting by causing notice to be posted in not less than five(5) conspicuous places in the Village, and by at least one notice in a newspaper circulating in the Village at least fourteen(14) days before the date of such a meeting. Such notice shall contain brief particulars of the purpose of the meeting and if its purpose is to seek approval for the borrowing of money, the amount of the proposed borrowing.

Chair to Preside:

3.02 The Chair shall preside at all electors meetings. The Chair shall state the purpose of the meeting and shall call for a discussion thereof.

Voting:

3.03 A) After the meeting has been opened for discussion for a sufficient length of time, the Chair shall call for a motion that the discussion shall cease and that voting take place.

B) All voting matters before the electors shall be decided by voting on a motion duly moved and seconded. Such voting to be by “yeas” and “nays”, and the Chair shall state whether the motion has been carried or defeated. Any two(2) electors may call for a standing vote on the motion. The Clerk/Treasurer shall count those standing in favor of the motion and those standing against the motion, and shall declare the numbers for and against the motion, and the Clerk/Treasurer shall record the same. In the case of a tie, the Chair shall declare the motion defeated.
