COMPETITION RULES

- 1. Absolutely no field entries.
- 2. No refunds after entries received
- 3. Numbers will be given out at the field.
- 4. First to enter, last to dance.
- New rule this year: Dancers who have forgotten their 2014 SOBHD card must pay a \$20 fee upon registration. Dancers can still compete and receive their awards at that time. Beginner and Novice dancers' cards will not be stamped until approval by ScotDance Provincial Registrar.
- 6. Dancers must report to dance area when their class is called or risk disqualification from that dance.
- 7. Age as of date of competition, July 1st.
- 8. Medals and trophies will be awarded in all categories except Primary where no trophy is awarded
- 9. Dancers must be in full dress to receive awards (including slippers).
- 10. Age categories will be determined according to the number of entries received.
- 11. Dancers will be judged according to the rules of the SOBHD.
- 12. Judges decisions is final; no access to the judges sheets.
- 13. Any protest must be lodged in writing and postmarked within 7 days, accompanied by a fee of \$25, which will be returned if the protest is upheld.
- 14. Pugwash Gathering of the Clans Highland Dance Competition will not be responsible for lost articles, accidents, injuries or illness to competitors or spectators at the competition.
- 15. No coaching by teachers or parents while dancers are on stage.

Dance fees: \$4 per dance plus \$5 Championship fees. (\$5 Championship fee includes \$4 for ScotDance NS and \$1 for ScotDance Canada). Dancers will compete in reverse order from when their registration forms, with **full payment,** arrive. First arriving registrations will dance last in their category. Registration by fax or email cannot be completed until full payment is made.

Change facilities will be made available at the Village Hall, which is directly across the road from Eaton Park and stage.

Only competing dancers and registered dance teachers will receive one courtesy gate pass. Please bring your SDTA, BATD or SDC card.

All others must pay gate admission of \$5 for adults and \$3 for students 5-12. Children under 5 - FREE



This is the 63rd anniversary of the Gathering of the Clans. The event started in 1951 to raise funds to build and maintain a hospital. Sixty three years later, the Village of Pugwash is preparing to build a Collaborative Emergency Care facility, and as a community we need to help raise funds to do this. The Gathering of the Clans is also a community fundraiser for other non profit groups, such as the Fire Department and Ground Search and Rescue.

Competitors, judges, stewards and (as of this year) registered dance teachers are not required to purchase an entrance fee. Everyone else should be sure to purchase their entrance bracelet at the ticket gates. Adults \$5, children/youths 12 and over the fee is \$3, children under 12 can enter FREE! We appreciate your support and cooperation in our drive to fund our new medical facility!

We hope that you enjoy your stay in this beautiful little Village. Stay all day and take in the other events of the day which include pipe and drum competitions at national historic site Thinkers' Lodge, heavyweight Highland games, Midway, artisan and food vendors, live music all afternoon and evening with fabulous fireworks at 10pm. The Canada Day Parade starts at 10am. There must be no street parking along the parade route which is: Church Street, Victoria Street, Water Street and King Street. Parking will be allowed on all but Water Street after the parade.

Early arrivals can enjoy a sausage and pancake breakfast for \$7 at the Pugwash fire station, just east of the Village limits, at 11057 Route 6 from 7am to 10am.

DIRECTIONS TO PUGWASH – from points east

- Coming from the east on the Trans Canada Highway HWY 104, take exit 11 at Glenholme and left onto Route 4 towards Folly Lake and Wentworth.
- After about 30km, in Wentworth, turn right onto Highway 307 towards Wallace and Pugwash.
- After 8.5km turn left towards Pugwash onto the Fountain Road, a short winding road which takes you to Howard's Bridge over Wallace River (single lane bridge) and then to Highway 368.
- At Hwy 368 turn right (north) towards Route 6 (Wallace and Pugwash) 7km.
- At Route 6 (Sunrise Trail) turn left (west) towards Pugwash 7km

DIRECTIONS TO PUGWASH – from points west

 Coming from the west on the Trans Canada Highway HWY 104, at Amherst take exit 3 towards Route 6 (Sunrise Trail) toward Victoria Street

- Follow the Sunrise Trail east to Pugwash ~60km
- In Pugwash Village, Route 6 (Sunrise Trail) is called Durham Street

- Security personnel will direct you where to park.
- Water Street will be blocked off to traffic all day, but there is ample parking throughout the Village. No parking on Church, Victoria or King Streets until after the Parade.
- Please keep clear of areas blocked off for disabled parking.
- There will be ample receptacles for garbage and recycling throughout the Village.
- Washrooms are available at the Village Hall and there are Porta Potties throughout the Village for the event.
