This CHB is one of 37 CHBs in Nova Scotia. CHBs promote healthy lifestyles and support groups that promote healthy lifestyles among the citizens they serve. Wallace, Wentworth, Pugwash, and Area CHB covers the north eastern corner of Cumberland County including Pugwash, Wallace, Wentworth, Westchester, Malagash, Port Howe, Port Philip, Linden and surrounding communities. Our coverage area goes to the town limits of Oxford and along the Northumberland Strait to Northport Consolidated Elementary School.

The CHB is a committed group of volunteers who are working to improve the health of the community. It advises Nova Scotia Health on local trends, perspectives, issues, and priorities. The CHB awards wellness grants each year to organizations or groups that propose activities that promote healthy lifestyles among our citizens.

The CHB participates in the development of a Community Health Plan with 9 other CHBs across the Northern Zone which includes, the counties of Colchester, East Hants, Pictou, and Cumberland. We are currently working on our new health plan which will run from 2024 to 2029. This will involve public input.
